We hope trainees will understand that the long-awaited overhaul of the joining criteria is a very significant and serious matter for this association. It is interlinked with many aspects of what we are here for- encouraging excellence, promoting safety ethics and offering recognised career progression. Physical competency and performance potential are the first steps to everything else. As such, it has been imperative to take time to robustly review each discipline and consider the wider reaches of the criteria in relation to the current stunt industry, as well as the maintenance and future progression of the British Stunt Register association.

On 31st October 2018 the former Joint Industry Stunt Committee (JISC) criteria for joining ceased to be recognised by the British Stunt Register, for applications received after that date.

All training to date remains relevant and we encourage trainees to continue training hard: our standards are high and the tests more stringent. The former JISC syllabus is a useful reference for the basis of a training program until the new criteria is published. It may be requested from our office. Trainees should not take any JISC tests and none should be offered - they will no longer be accepted as part of an application for membership of the BSR.
